

- 1. Mount headrod brackets 3 ½" in from each side of the awning width. These locations will be at the top of the arch opening on the backside of the fabric.
 - There will be extra arch openings and brackets for wider awnings.







- 2. Slide the headrod in the top pocket.
- 3. Slide the front bar through the lower pocket in the fabric above the valance.
- 4. Screw the arms to the front bar. Hinges and screws will be on the arms.
- 5. Place the top of the awning with the fiberglass headrod inside the pocket on the headrod brackets. The brackets should be hidden behind the fabric.
- 6. Let arms hang down while installing arm hinges. Hinges will be attached to the armsremove to install.
- 7. Mount hinges 4" below perpendicular. This will be your drop measurement plus 4 inches. Distance between center of hinges will be the width of awning you ordered.
- 8. Arms can mount at any desired position. This will change the drop and projection of the fabric.
